- 1) Call to order at 7:12
- 2) Review of December minutes. Class 6A is 174 and below (15-E-iii-2). Class 6B is 177 and above. MSP.

- 3) Brian Hull brought left-over trophies

- 4) Mike Roach commented that Cabrillo IV has a date conflict with the NOOD. SWYC will be looking into changing date. Race courses overlap in the Coronado Roads.
- 5) Don mentioned Area G uses same rules as PHRF SoCal. Also, we need representation from all classes. Class 2 we may have a problem with representation.
- 6) Dennis Pennell was thinking that Mid-Winters were being dropped for Class 1A. At least 3 boats would like to race. Don pointed out that the class will not be scored for Hi-Point. We have 6 boats in Class 1A, 6 boats in Class 1B. Yacht clubs may choose to keep class together.

- 9) Catalina 36 – *CheriMarie* – Sail #56300.
 - a) Warren motioned for a rating of 144/144/144, Mike Roach seconded
 - b) Motion passed unanimously
- 10) Beneteau 36.7 – *Kaizen* – Sail #7020
 - a) Warren motioned for a rating of 81/81/84, Ron Coalson seconded
 - b) Motion passed unanimously
- 11) Cal T2 – *Elysium* – Sail #33
 - a) Warren motioned for a rating of 186/186/186, Mike Roach seconded
 - b) Has an outboard.
 - c) So-Cal has inboard at 192.
 - d) Motion passed unanimously
- 12) J80 – *Underdog* – Sail #85
 - a) Warren motioned for a rating of 120/108/102 – SoCal standard rating, seconded
 - b) Other J80s have raced with OD ratings. Mike McGinty pointed out that there are no other J80s with a current PHRF Cert.
 - c) Provisionally provide cert with stipulation that request be completely filled in with missing data – JC, IC, and no A-Sym measurements.
 - d) Motion passed unanimously for conditional rating
- 13) Carrera 290 – *Road Trip* – Sail #2915
 - a) Don motioned we research with SoCal and find their rating before providing a new one.
 - b) Brian Hull motioned to table – passed unanimously.

Rating Reviews

- 14) *Deliverance* requested a rating review. Information came in too late. Warren will investigate and we will re-look at the issue next month.
- 15) Warren brought up IOR boats from Mexico. Gary motioned to table until next month when Frank Whidden is here. MSP.

Second Readings

- 16) Fleet 1. Everybody signed Dennis Conner's motion except for Alec Oberschmidt. Reading 1 was accepted with the understanding that Dennis Conner would notify all Class 1 owners.
- a) Question as to whether or not Alec was properly notified.
 - b) Marty pointed out that he spoke with Alec and Alec is aware of the first reading.
 - c) Mike McGinty called Alec and notified him Staghound's rating would be 51/51/51.
 - d) We will send out a second reading notice to handle next month.
- 17) Ranger 33.
- a) Marty pointed out they will be racing in the new Class 4. Of the 13 boats mentioned before, only 5 in new class will be faster than Ranger 33's, 7 will be slower. The purpose of the review was to put them with more like boats, and after the new class assignments, they will be with those boats.
 - b) Bob Randall thinks we have solved his issue. He brought supporting documentation with race results.
 - c) Mike Roach raced the boat for a number of years. Did very well off-shore and won PHRF. Boat became hard to race against the light boats that are no longer in the class.
 - d) Only 2 Ranger 33's are actively racing.
 - e) Warren motions we rate 156/150/150. Ron Coalsen seconded. Motion fails.
 - f) Marty motions 153/147/147. No seconds to this motion.
