3. Handicapping:

a) Rating Reviews:

i) ""Conquest" a Cal 40 with Sail #96. Owner Jon Sanchioli.

The current PHRF certificate for Conquest is 114/114/114/. In comparison with Nozomi", which has a PHRF SOCAL certificate regional rating of 114/114/114 and an Area G off set of +3/+3+3 (117/117/117), our option is to give the same 3 second rating to Conquest or vote to remove the offset for Area G and send it to SOCAL as an Area Change. All data bases currently show a 114 rating.

A motion was made by Joe Saad to provide a 117 provisional rating for 1 year. **MSP.**

ii) "Nauti Nan" a Catalina 30 with Sail No. 2081. Owner Scott Lagerquist.

A taller rig dimension was reported in error on his application and he had been rated accordingly. A new certificate will be issued with the correct standard rig dimensions of 35.5 with rating of 198/198/198.
