Owner is requesting a rating review for OWC with a +6 second credit (21/21/27). A motion was made by Mike Riddle to make an adjustment of a +6, 9, or 12 second credit. Carolyn Sherman made a motion for a +6 adjustment MSP.
- ii) "Bad Pak" a McConaghy STP-65 with Sail No. 65002. Owner Tom Holtus. Current rating is -129/-135/-138. Represented by Scott Lowry. Owner is adding an

MHG to be used offshore. In comparison, SOCAL ratings are:

Inshore/frag rig -123/-126/-132,

Offshore/mh rig -135/135/141.

Tom is requesting a 3 to 6 second offset, based on consistent lighter winds. Jim Baumgart made a motion for a rating adjustment of -123/-126/-132 MHG inshore Jim also made a motion to match SOCAL's rating of -135/-135/-141 – MHG offshore

 One board member made a motion for no change for either boat, based on the fact that the Board had previously rated Oly at the owner's request by way of a formal rating review and had given him the rating of 99/99/99. It was decided that the owner of "Cheap Thrills" will need to make the same request by way of a rating review. MSP.
