- 1) From Brad Alberts Would ask SoCal about the MIR rule? PHRF states the following in it's Class Rules (emphasis added): 'PHRF does not rate skippers or crew, ONLY the boat. Skippers who solicit individuals to crew who derive their living or monetary gain from on-the-water racing, or by improving methods of systems for racing may be taking unfair advantage of a skipper who races with a non-professional crew. PHRF has established the Marine Industry Racer (MIR) Rule to compensate for this inequity.' It appears that Pro drivers, trimmers, tacticians and the like are in direct contradiction to the stated PHRF's Fundamental Concepts. Local OA's only waive Section 8 (MIR Rule) because PHRFSD suggests they waive it.
