- Temporary Ratings about to expire – NONE - *PHRF SoCal has changed the By Laws so there are no more “provisional” ratings and a “Temporary” rating is for a 30 day*

period only. So designed to allow a boat to enter a particular race on short notice. The temporary rating automatically expires after 30 days and the member must reapply for a regular certificate.

- Hot Dog, 56751, Capri 22 – from Chief Handicapper: By the way that data for Hot Dog is incorrect. I don't think I've ever seen a Capri 22 with a SL of 15' and a SMG of 18'. The LP of 10' is also wrong. Please ask him to look up the numbers and correct them so they can be added to his certificate.
- Charisma, 60671, Grand Soleil 45 – from past meetings: Action: Jon Gardner to follow up with Joe Erskine about measuring these two boats. *From Chief Handicapper: 2' bowsprit, no pole – I suggest the standard could be 81/75/75, with 2' sprit, and NO regular pole I suggest 82/72/76 – From the Board: wait until Fleet Scorer/Measurer can measure Vanquish and Charisma. Joe and Jon not here - Tabled to next month – current meeting: need data from Joe Erskine, Fleet measurer*

- CLASS ADJUSTMENTS

If a boat is within 6 seconds of a Class Break it may request to change to the next lower or higher class. This can be done only once in a calendar year or once for the upcoming or current Yearly Class Championship Series. The Board will agree or not.

- ANONYMOUS RATING REVIEW – FROM PHRF SoCal Class Rules:

1. *The Regional Board may initiate a Rating Review of a boat owned by a PHRF Member without a request by the Member / owner or by an identified competitor as set forth above in section 4.2 if and only if three (3) PHRF members, within any twelve month period, submit requests that a specific boat be reviewed using the link on the PHRF SoCal website.*

2. *In the event that three such requests are received within one year, the Fleet Secretary shall notify the Chief Handicapper of such requests and thereupon issue notice to the PHRF Member / owner of the boat in question as provided in Rule 4.2a above. The Rating Review shall be conducted pursuant to the provisions of Rule 4.2, except that the names of the three Members who requested the Rating Review shall be confidential and not be revealed except to members of the Executive Board.*
3. *No boat shall be the subject of more than one Anonymous Rating Review within any twelve month period.*
