## FROM PHRF SoCal Class Rules:

- 1. The Regional Board may initiate a Rating Review of a boat owned by a PHRF Member without a request by the Member / owner or by an identified competitor as set forth above in section 4.2 if and only if three (3) PHRF members, within any twelve month period, submit requests that a specific boat be reviewed using the link on the PHRF SoCal website.
- 2. In the event that three such requests are received within one year, the Fleet Secretary shall notify the Chief Handicapper of such requests and thereupon issue notice to the PHRF Member / owner of the boat in question as provided in Rule 4.2a above. The Rating Review shall be conducted pursuant to the provisions of Rule 4.2, except that the

names of the three Members who requested the Rating Review shall be confidential and not be revealed except to members of the Executive Board.

- 3. No boat shall be the subject of more than one Anonymous Rating Review within any twelve month period.
