Discussion: although PHRF SD has been working to obtain VPP data for all boats not all have been obtained so far – consequently PHRF SD cannot practically provide new ratings using information obtained from VPP data to all boats before January 1, 2024

Action: Suspend the requirement that every boat provide a VPP prior to renewal for 2024 but continue that requirement that all boats that have not yet provided a VPP must do so prior to March 31, 2024 with the intention that PHRF SD will assign new ratings to all boats that are enhanced through using information from VPP data not later than June 30, 2024 – additionally PHRF SD will not renew and no longer assign ratings to boats that currently have a negative rating and will not accept applications from new boats that would likely expect to receive a negative rating because PHRF SD believes it cannot accurately rate boats that would likely expect to be assigned a negative rating

Vote: YES unanimous

Action for members: all current boats other than those with current negative ratings are now eligible to renew their current rating for 2024 and should do so as soon as possible

- TEMPORARY RATINGS ABOUT TO EXPIRE A Temporary Rating may be provided by Chief handicapper in the event a handicap is requested to race in an upcoming race which will take place before a meeting, and the board is unable to vote on the rating (Prior to race). The request should be email approved or voted on at next board meeting to make permanent. In the event at a board meeting where an owner has submitted an application, fees are paid, but the Board believes it does not have sufficient data or information to accurately rate a boat, a Temporary rating may be provided with the understanding the owner should submit race results during the three months to show data, to verify the Temporary Rating. Temporary rating may be adjusted after review of results. In the event the data is not provided the temporary rating will be considered expired at the end of 120 days. A new complete application (Minus Fees) will need to be presented to board to have the boat considered again for a PHRF certificate. The Chief Handicapper may, at his or her discretion, renew the Temporary Rating twice.
